## COMMONWEALTH SUSTAINABLE CITIES PROGRAMME 24 JUNE-02 SEPTEMBER 2020

A total of 19 online events over 10 weeks attracted over 2,000 participants from 44 Commonwealth and 44 non-Commonwealth countries who engaged with 106 panellists from 31 countries: amounting to over 4,000 unique views.

The range of topics considered included: Planning for Rapid Urbanisation, Decentralisation and Local Empowerment, Building Professional Capacity, Local Economic Development, Infrastructure-led Community Resilience, Affordable Housing for All, Climate Responsive Design, and the challenges facing Small Island States.


